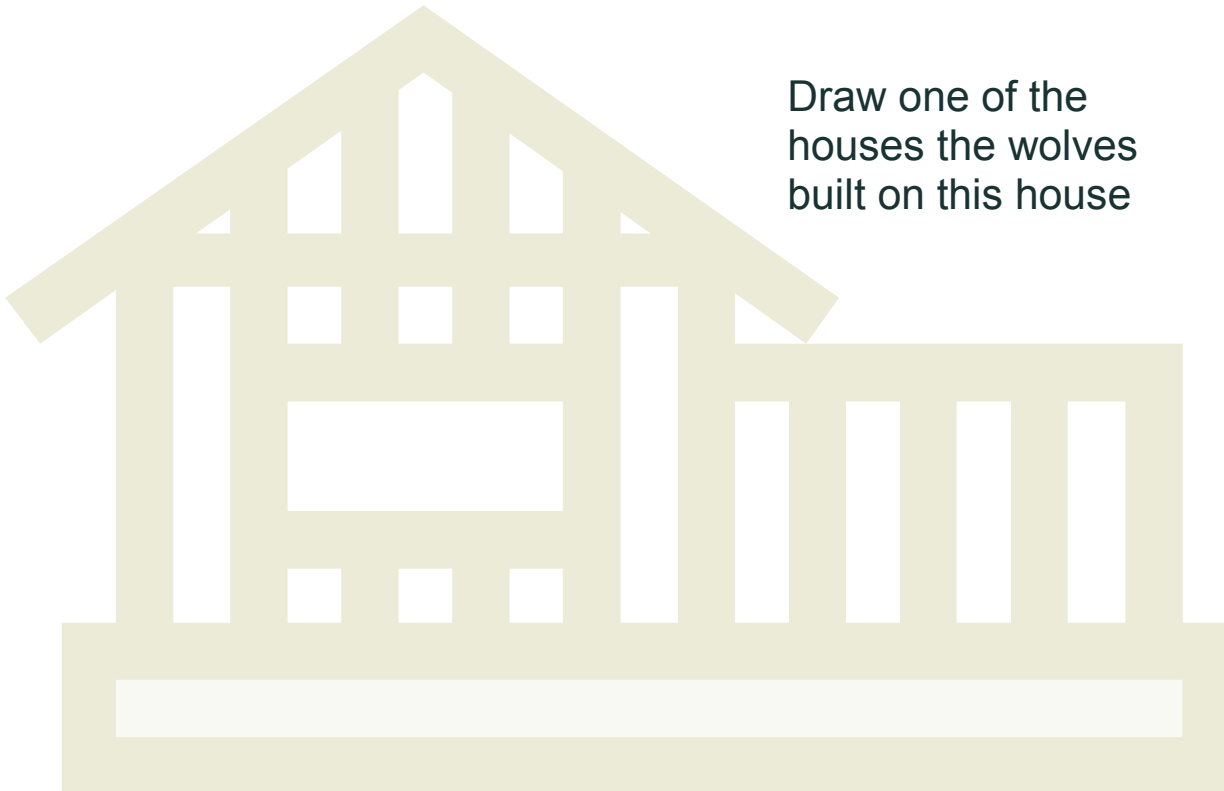
1. **Central Idea:** the main thought or principal theme of a work of literature

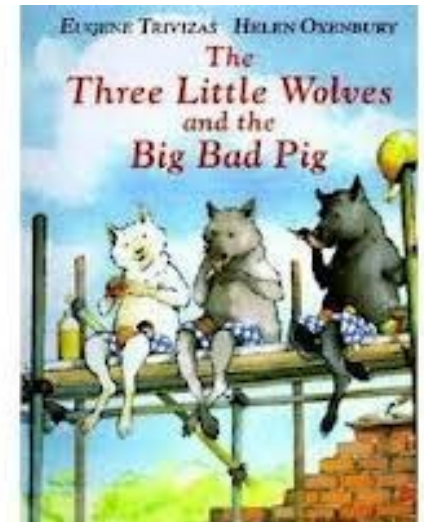
1. What is the material the wolves built their first house out of?

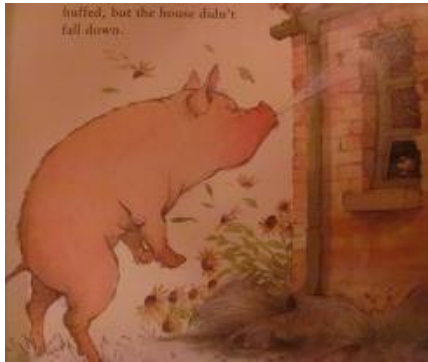
